We want to inform you that District 2232 has formed a Coordinating Committee for the Prevention of Humanitarian Disaster, focused on helping victims of the war in Ukraine and coordinating support from RI. The Committee is in touch with the major hospitals to determine urgent needs.

Nowadays the urgent needs are medicines. Because of inhuman actions of Russian army, we have a lot of injured civilians. We purchased and delivered the medicines needed by hospitals for affected people.

Regarding safe payments to Ukraine, I confirm that the local bank system is stable, works very well, and has the possibility of e-banking. We opened the special accounts for donations from outside. We try do not to keep funds on the account and purchase medicines as fast as possible.


